- Passed a background check (PSOR) prior to working in the classroom



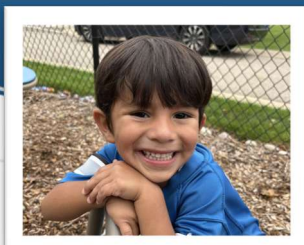

## 3-year-old Program

12:30 PM – 3:00 PM

- Monday & Wednesday
- Fabulous first experience which includes an introduction to letters, colors, shapes, and counting
- Emphasis on learning social skills including self-help skills and taking turns

## 4-year-old Program Options

9:00 AM – 11:30 AM

- Monday & Wednesday
- Tuesday & Thursday
- Optional Friday
- Instruction on letter formation and sounds
- Emphasis on kindergarten readiness

Twin Discount: Pay full price for one child & receive a 50% discount for the second child.

All classes are contingent on enrollment numbers. Tuition assistance is available based on eligibility.

## Pre-K Program (4's & 5's)

9:00 AM – 11:30 AM

- Monday-Thursday
- Optional Friday
- Half day program
- Allows for an extra year of growth
- Instruction includes letter formations, sounds, early reading skills, and math concepts
- Weekly sight word, compound word, and individualized reading cards
- Emphasis on kindergarten readiness
